## **GENERAL CHARITABLE TRUST**

Whilst the Charity may give support to any charitable purpose, as defined in the Charities Act 2006, it has been the practice to concentrate the Charity's finite resources in the support of:

1. Educational awards for success in the examinations of the Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators (ICSA) and in collaborative courses between the ICSA and several Universities.
2. Support for Apprentices of the Livery Company in their ICSA studies.
3. Education and social welfare in the City of London and Inner London Boroughs.
4. The charities nominated annually by the Lord Mayor of the City of London and by the Master of the Livery Company.
5. Charities relating to current and former members of the Armed Services and Awards for members of those branches of the Armed Services with which the Livery Company has affiliations.

Other than awards within the above categories, the Charity does not normally give financial support to individuals.
