to whom these Presents shall come Alexander Colin Cole Esquire Commander of the Royal Victorian Order upon whom has been conferred the Territorial Decoration, Garter Principal King of Arms Sir Anthony Richard Wagner Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order Clarenceux King of Arms and Walter John George Verco Esquire Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Norroy and Ulster King of Arms and Her Majesty's Serjeant at Arms John Allevyn Wedgwood Gentleman Master of the Worshipful Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators hath represented unto The Most Noble Miles Francis Duke of Norfolk Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England that the Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators having prayed the Lord Mayor and Aldermen of the City of London that the said Company might be constituted a Livery Company of the City of London upon the Nineteenth day of July 1977 it was granted and confirmed and ratified by the Lord Mayor and Aldermen unto the good men of the Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators that they be a Livery Company of the City of London by the name of the Worshipful Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators and that the Company enjoy a Livery and further inter alia that the Constitutions and Ordinances of the said Company be enrolled among the records of the Court of the Mayor and Aldermen and that the grant of Livery be embodied in Letters Patent under the Majesty's Seal which Letters Patent on the Twelfth day of January 1978 were signed and sealed accordingly That the Master Wardens & Court of Assistants of the Worshipful Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators are desirous of having Armorial Ensigns established with lawful authority and he therefore as Master of the said Company and on behalf of the same hath requested the favour of His Grace's Warrant for the granting and assigning such Arms and Crest and in the same Patent such Supporters and such Device or Badge as We may consider fit and proper to be borne & used by the Worshipful Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators on Seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms And whereas as the said Earl Marshal did by Warrant under his hand and Seal bearing date the Twenty-seventh day of July 1978 authorize and direct Us to grant and assign such Arms and Crest and in the same Patent such Supporters and such Device or Badge accordingly Know Ye therefore that We the said Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster in pursuance of His Grace's Warrant and by virtue of the Letters Patent of Our several Offices to each of Us respectively granted do by these Presents grant and assign unto the **WORSHIPFUL COMPANY OF CHARTERED SECRETARIES AND ADMINISTRATORS** the Arms following that is to say:—



— Azure standing on a Book Argent edged Gules and with marker Or a Secretary Bird Or in chief two Towers with buttresses Argent masoned Gules And for the Crest Upon a Helm with a Wreath Argent Azure and Gules A Petasus Azure winged Or thereon a Lion passant of the last holding in the dexter forepaw a Scroll palewise proper with pendant Ribbon and Seal Gules and tied with Ribbons also Gules Mantled Azure and Orles divided Argent and Or And We do further grant and assign the following Device or Badge that is to say:— Within a Wreath Argent Azure and Gules a Key Or and a Quill Pen saltirewise Azure And by the Authority aforesaid I the said Garter do by these Presents further grant and assign unto the **WORSHIPFUL COMPANY OF CHARTERED SECRETARIES AND ADMINISTRATORS** the Supporters following that is to say:— On the dexter side a Dragon sejant Argent winged Or and on the sinister side a Griffin sejant Argent beaked legged and winged Or each gorged with a Wreath Argent and Gules pendent therefrom by a Ring a Key Or and a Quill Pen saltirewise Azure as the same are all in the margin hereof more plainly depicted to be borne and used for ever hereafter by the Worshipful Company of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators on Seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms In witness whereof We the said Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms have to these Presents subscribed Our names and affixed the Seals of Our several Offices this Seventh day of May in the Twenty-ninth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith and in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty.
